Please note that the 2011 Affiliation fees will include HST and will be due to the OAAS by December 31, 2010.

ATTENTION ALL OAAS MEMBERS: EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2010. Any fairs, service members or affiliate members who have not paid their annual fees to the OAAS by February 1st, will NOT have information printed in the annual OAAS Directory or brochure, be posted on the OAAS website, receive any mailings from the OAAS including annual complimentary fair passes etc.

Once payment is received the membership will be reinstated and benefits resumed. If you do not receive an invoice from OAAS by December, please contact us.

<u>C.A.F.E.</u> has reached an agreement with Re:Sound with respect to how their Tariff 5 (Music to Accompany Live Events) will apply to the fairs, festivals and exhibitions industry. We have agreed with Re:Sound on a draft tariff that has been filed with the Copyright Board and we are currently waiting for the Board's approval and certification. Re:Sound will not start collecting royalties under Tariff 5 until it has been certified by the Copyright Board. At that time, detailed information will be provided to you as to how the tariff will apply and the amount of the royalties payable.

Tariff 5 applies to the years 2008 to 2012 and royalties are payable for the entire term of the tariff regardless of when it is certified by the Copyright Board. However, as a <u>confidential</u> term of the settlement agreement, Re:Sound has agreed that it will not collect royalties under Tariff 5 from our members for the period of January I, 2008 to December 3I, 2009, provided they make timely payment of applicable royalties when due. This agreement to waive payment of royalties for 2008 and 2009 must be kept confidential by the fairs and exhibitions in accordance with the terms of the settlement agreement.

Agricultural Society Annual Return & Grant Application forms are due February 1st 2011

INTERESTING FACTS:

- To maintain corporate legal status all agricultural societies in Ontario must file an annual return with OMAFRA.
- Annual return includes statement of the number of society members, a list of officers and directors for the incoming year & an audited financial statements.
- To receive a grant your agricultural society must complete all required forms. All grants are paid based on society eligibility and are a reimbursement of eligible expenditures.
- All societies must submit forms by February 1st, 2011.
- Forms must be sent to the designated OMAFRA offices or completed online.

FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE BY NOVEMBER 15th AND CAN BE COMPLETED ONLINE.
